

BMO Funds Tax Information - Calendar 2018

Tax-Exempt Income Earned By State, Commonwealth or Territory of the United States (as a percentage)

Some states allow the mutual fund shareholder to reduce the amount of tax-exempt income they include on their state income tax return by the proportionate amount of tax-exempt income that they receive from their mutual fund that is derived from tax-exempt obligations issued within their State or by a Commonwealth or Territory of the United States. The following schedule indicates the percentage of tax-exempt income that is earned by the Fund from State, Commonwealth, or Territory of the United States obligations.
