**Corporate Dividend Received Deduction (DRD)
(as a percentage)**

Eligible U.S. corporations invested in one of the following BMO Funds may be entitled to a 50% dividends received deduction that is attributable to qualified dividends received from U.S. corporations. The following schedule indicates the percentage of the ordinary income dividends paid in calendar 2018 that are eligible for the corporate dividend received deduction. Apply the percentage to the ordinary income dividends paid by your fund, which include distributions from income and any distributions from short-term capital gains. Please consult your tax adviser to determine what is appropriate for your situation.
